# Haka

Tēnā tātou i runga i ngā āhuatanga o te wā,

This year the Whanganui-ā-Tara Māori Teachers association are holding the first haka composition competition for the secondary schools and wharekura from Te Whanganui-ā-Tara ki Ōtaki.

The purpose for the competition is to select a haka that our rohe will be able to perform at national hui such as kapa haka, Ngā Manu Kōrero, Waka Ama and other cultural or sporting events.

We will incorporate the competition with a wānanga where all who attend will learn a mōteatea, a haka pohiri and the winning haka. We would like representatives from all schools to come and partake in the wānanga even if you are not competing.

**Place Kāpiti College Gymnasium**

**Start : 9am**

**Finish: 5pm**

### **Rules**

- Haka must be no longer than two minutes and no shorter than 45 seconds. 5 Marks will be deducted from the total score for every 10 seconds over or under.
- The words must represent the rohe, Te Whanganui-ā-Tara ki Ōtaki
- Students currently involved in a full time course of study in a Wharekura or Secondary School must compose and choreograph the haka. They are permitted to submit the haka for editing by an adult.
- It must be able to be performed by Tane and Wahine. But may be performed by wahine or tane on the day (keeping single sex schools in mind)
- It must be neutral enough to use on all occasions
- If iwi are mentioned in the haka, it must include all of the iwi in our rohe
- It must have set actions.

Note: The winning haka will not be selected because of the strength of the performance. It will be up to the judges professional judgement as to which haka is the best based on the criteria. The judges will mark the performance, however this will not be included in the aggregate mark for the winning haka.

Also you do not need a full kapa haka group to perform your haka, nor is traditional kākahu required.

You must be prepared to teach your haka on the day if you win.

There may be more than one entry per kura

There will be a prize presented to the team who wins to contribute towards their fundraising.

The winning haka will be put be on the kāpiti college website so all schools may have access to the words and the video.

**You must submit your kupu with a translation one week prior to the competition date. Your kupu must have the following information:**

**12.30** Start teaching winning haka (allow 1 ½ hours)

**2pm** – Break

**2.15** – learn Mōteatea (allow 1 ½ hours)

**2.45** – Break

**4pm** – learn Haka Pohiri

**5pm** – Karakia Whakamutunga – Hoki ki te kāinga
