ENROLMENT DAY

Tuesday 26 January: 9.00am – 11 am (Surnames A-L) and 12-30-2-00pm (Surnames M-Z) in the college hall .

This day is for:

- (a) **All students** who are returning to college who were in **year 11 or 12 in 2009. Bring your NCEA results slip with you**
- (b) **All new pupils** except those who completed enrolment formalities last year. Such enrolments will only be made with parents present. Please ring the college for an appointment time. Please bring documentation, including birth certificates and reports from the previous school to this interview.

Please note that year 11 students in 2010 are not required to attend enrolment day unless they wish to discuss a subject change.

Attendance on enrolment day is essential so that students have the best opportunity to be placed in the subjects of their choice. Students who do not attend run the risk of not being able to gain places in their preferred subjects.

STARTING DATES AND TIMES

Tuesday 2nd February: Year 9 and 10 begin with assembly 8.55am in the new College Gymnasium. Students need to ensure that they have writing materials for classes. There will be a powhiri for Year 9 students from 10-20am at the College marae. Parents are welcome to attend. Students are reminded to bring hats and sunscreen. The school day ends at 3.30pm

Tuesday 2nd February: First day for all year 11, 12 and 13s begins with an assembly at 9-30 am in the College Hall. Seniors will be dismissed at 11am. Those with timetable issues will be required to remain after 11 am.

Wednesday 3rd February: All students to attend 8.55am – 3.30pm. (Note that late start day will be Thursday in 2010)

BUS ARRANGEMENTS

Mana Coach Services buses serve routes to and from Waikanae Beach(departs 7.50am) via Waikanae Village; North Beach Paraparaumu Routes 262/250(departs 7.55) and 261/250 (departs 7.57); Paraparaumu Railway Station Route 250 (departs 7.58am and 8.30am) direct College. Buses meet 8.40am incoming Train and Raumati South Route 250 (stops Jeep Road @ 8.20am). Mana Coach Services have a special leaflet prepared for our students or check details at

www.manacoach.co.nz/schools/kapiti_college/index.html.

Note that bus and train passes for these services must be obtained directly from Mana Coach Services or Tranz Metro. Students need to purchase these before the start of the term or pay for each individual trip until they do. We strongly advise the use of term passes.

Southern Bus: Kapiti College provides a bus that bus collects students from Bridge Shop, Paremata (7.45am), Plimmerton (under SH1 overbridge at 7.50am), Pukerua Bay (SH1 bus stop at top of Beach Rd at 8.00am), then on a Paekakariki circuit from 8.10am: stopping outside St James Church, Ocean Rd; Te Miti Street (opposite Haumia Rd); Wellington Rd, corner of Miriona Grove; then direct to Kapiti College.

Term passes for the Southern bus are obtained only through the school office or through internet banking. (account number 12-3157-0166870-00, reference, South Bus, particulars, child's surname and initials) and must be purchased by Friday 23rd January.
